Torre Fornello, fine brand of Italian wine, celebrates contemporary jewellery with the Award annually assigned for the international competition **Gioielli in Fermento**.

During the Barcelona Jewellery Week, the **Off JOYA** program, from October 5 to 10, represents an unconventional path through contemporary jewellery. One of the main events will take the visitor to enjoy a wide look on the 2015 edition of **Gioielli in Fermento** displayed in the spaces of **Cassina Barcelona** showroom.

Impressive varieties in colours, forms, concepts for the workpieces of **Gioielli in Fermento** illustrate the themes of taste and wine's *terroir* arising from typical Emilia landscapes and considering, by extension, the Mediterranean subject as it has inspired authors from across Europe and from Brazil, Colombia, S.Korea, Venezuela.

Opening by invitation is on **Monday, October 5th at h.19,00** to present the project supported by Torre Fornello winery, estate based in Valtidone on the border between Emilia, Lombardy and Piedmont Italian regions, who offered the ideal context for international contemporary jewellery award since 2011 and supports the exhibit in Italy and abroad. A tasting of the finest wines of Torre Fornello will be reserved to guests.

The exhibition in Barcelona after the inauguration, will follow Cassina showroom opening hours and will remain set until October 10th (free admission, hrs. 10,00 - 19,00 - saturday 10,00 - 14,00).

Most of the artworks shown are available for sale under reservation and delivered at the end of the exhibition.

Torre Fornello, Italy

Enrico Sgorbati is in charge of the family winery since 1991. The first vintage was produced by Torre Fornello in 1998. The winery is focused on high quality production and it put the accent to the autochthonous vines. Its lands are located in Valtidone, in the geological area of “old red soils”. It is here that nature created those lands and that climate that are ideal for the vines that were cultivated already in ancient roman times. The winery cultivates its vines partly under a biological scheme and partly under a low environmental impact program which is both beneficial for the countryside and healthy for the human being. Vinification happens in a 1.000 sq mt space equipped with the highest technological machinery where grapes are treated with the highest respect. Refining happens in French allier barriques that lay in the original ancient winery dating from the 15th and 17th centuries; here the constant temperature allows wines to acquire elegance without changing the grapes particular characteristics.
